Timeshare Calculation Example 1

The high earning parent has the child one day per week for 50 weeks (50 days per year), plus split holidays including one child's birthday (6 days), plus two weeks during the summer (14 days). The calculations are:

$$50 + 6 + 14 = 70 \text{ days}$$

$$70 \div 365 \text{ days/year} = .19$$

$$.19 \times 100 = 19\% \text{ timeshare}$$

This calculation has to be made for each child—often the calculation will be the same, but not always.
