

## Jury Instructions Checklist for Traffic Cases

- CALCRIM 2142:** Lesser included offense of failing to perform duty after accident that caused injury or property damage [see VC §§20001, 20003, 20004]
- CALCRIM 2150:** Driver failing to perform duty after accident that caused property damage [see VC §20002; *People v Carbajal* (1995) 10 C4th 1114, 1123 n10]
- CALCRIM 2151:** Nondriving owner or passenger in control failing to perform duty after accident that caused property damage [see VC §20002; *People v Carbajal* (1995) 10 C4th 1114, 1123 n10]
- CALCRIM 2180:** Evading Peace Officer: Death or Serious Bodily Injury [VC §§2800.1(a), 2800.3(a), (b)]
- CALCRIM 2181:** Evading Peace Officer: Reckless Driving [VC §§2800.1(a), 2800.2]
- CALCRIM 2182:** Evading Peace Officer: Misdemeanor [VC §2800.1(a)]
- CALCRIM 2200:** Reckless driving [see VC §23103(a), (b)]
- CALCRIM 2201:** Engaging in a speed contest [see VC §23109(c), (e)(2), (f)]
- CALCRIM 2202:** Engaging in an exhibition of speed [see VC §23109(c)]
- CALCRIM 2220:** Driving with a suspended or revoked license [see VC §§13106, 14601, 14601.1, 14601.2, 14601.5]
- CALCRIM 2221:** Driving without a valid driver license [see VC §12500(a)]
- CALCRIM 2222:** Failing to present a driver license to a peace officer [see VC §12951(b)]
- CALCRIM 2240:** Failing to appear in court or pay a fine [see VC §40508(a)]
